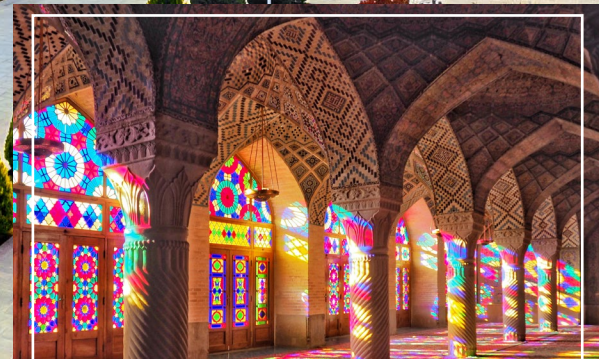

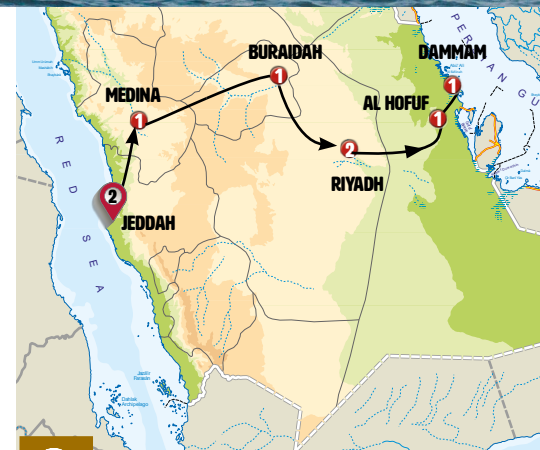

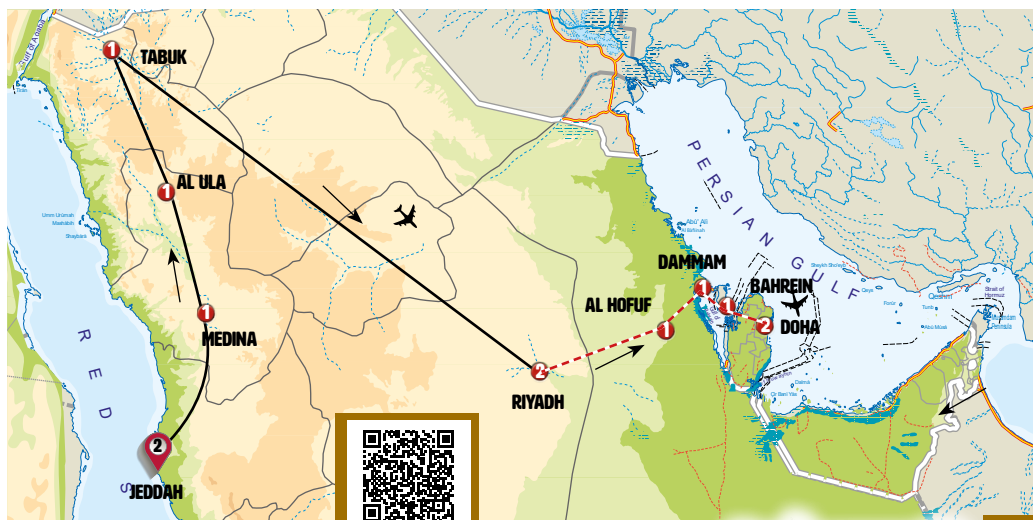

We continue the visit of Alexandria including the catacombs Kom Ash Shuqqafa, a cemetery that fuses the pharaonic and Greco-Roman styles, the Column of Pompey, or the exterior of the new Library of Alexandria. Lunch included. Afterwards we will go to the pleasant city of Rosetta, next to the Nile, and we will be able to see a replica of the Rosetta Stone that allowed the interpretation of Egyptian hieroglyphs in the fortress of Rashid.

**13 WED. Cairo.-**

After breakfast, transfer to the airport and end of our services.

**14 THU. Luxor.-**

Day in Luxor, ancient Thebes, city of great temples and necropolis. We'll take a boat to cross the Nile. We will visit Deir el-Medina, an ancient Egyptian village of workers and artisans. ### (Opt. 1) Dreams of Persia

#### 01 THU. Tehran.-

Welcome to Iran's capital, Tehran! In the afternoon we will give an introductory tour of this modern city of almost 10 million inhabitants, including the Shrine of Imamzadeh Saleh. Afterwards, we'll go to the mountainous town of Darband, very close to Tehran. Dinner included.

#### 02 FRI. Tehran.-

Panoramic tour of Tehran with tickets included going to Milad Tower, National Museum and Golestan Palace. Lunch included. In the afternoon we will visit the National Jewelry Museum.

#### 03 SAT. Tehran - Mausoleum-Shrine of Imam Khomeini - Qom - Kashan.-

After breakfast, on the outskirts of Tehran, we visit the Mausoleum-Shrine of Imam Khomeini, considered the founder of the Islamic Republic. We continue to Qom, one of the holiest Shiite pilgrimage centers in the Islamic world, which we will have the opportunity to visit accompanied by an Islamic scholar. Lunch included. In the afternoon, we go to Kashan stopping first at the wonderful Fin Garden of the Nineteenth Century.

#### 04 SUN. Kashan - Underground City - Caravanserai Abouzeyd - Abyaneh - Isfahan.-

Visit Kashan whose heritage includes a beautiful mosque, gardens and palatial houses. We'll visit its historic Hammam and taste its typical flower drink. After that, we will head to the archaeological site of Tappeh Sialk, a ziggurat of one of the first civilizations.
